Resolution of the Town of Woodboro, Oneida County, State of Wisconsin

WHEREAS, Oak Wilt, is a fatal fungus disease and,
WHEREAS, Oak Wilt has been found in Oneida County and,
WHEREAS, oak trees are most easily infected by overland spread in spring time, the Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources recommends that one should avoid pruning, cutting, and wounding oak from April 15, through July 15, and
WHEREAS, the Town of Woodboro understands the importance of the oak tree to our town and the management of the disease the Town of Woodboro intends to proceed on this course,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town of Woodboro will not mow or brush the town roads before July 15.
