You are also to adhere to the following conditions for the Town of Woodboro:

- Fireworks display must be administered by a State licensed certified professional pyrotechnic. Copy of certification and license required and given to the Town of Woodboro Clerk prior to issuance of permit.
- 2. Limit display to 30 minutes and no displays after 11 p.m.
- 3. Weather permitting (high winds, DNR current fire conditions).
- 4. You MUST have a Town of Cassian or Town of Crescent fire truck and personnel at location of display. (Fireworks Professional is to make the necessary arrangements with the Fire Chief.)
- 5. You MUST notify the Oneida County Sheriff's Department at least one week prior to the event.
- 6. You MUST comply with all State of Wisconsin Statutes 167.10.
- 7. You are required to file a liability policy in the name of the Town of Woodboro in the amount of \$1,000,000 that will indemnify other persons for any injuries to persons or property arising out of the use of the fireworks. Copy of Certificate of Insurance to be provided to the Town of Woodboro along with application.
- 8. Fee of \$100 must be received by the Woodboro Town Clerk.

A copy of permit must be given to the Cassian Fire Dept., 3980 Harshaw Rd., Harshaw, WI 54529 or Crescent Fire Dept., 3231 Golf Course Rd., Rhinelander, WI 54501, AND Oneida County Sheriff's Dept., 2000 E. Washington St., Rhinelander, WI 54501, at least 7 days before the date of authorized use.
