

ORDINANCE # 21-10

WARD DIVISION AND DESIGNATING POLLING PLACE(S)

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodboro, Oneida County, Wisconsin is responsible for ward division and designating polling places in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of October, 2021, the Town of Woodboro made and passed a motion to separate said Town of Woodboro into 1 ward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of Supervisors does hereby create one ward, as follows:

Ward One – the entire population of the Town of Woodboro, Oneida County, Wisconsin. The entire town is located within the Rhinelander School District boundaries (see attached map).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward will be combined, using one common polling place, which is named the Woodboro Town Hall and the address is 8672 Old Hwy K Rd., Harshaw, WI.


