2025 Property Tax Collection

- Your entire real estate bill, or your first installment is due by January 31, 2026
- **MAKE PAYMENTS TO: TOWN OF WOODBORO**
- Please make sure that your payment matches total amount due
- There will be no in-person collecting of taxes

Tax payments can be paid by mail or dropped off. The town hall mailbox is a secure lock box so you can drop them off at any time. Please remember to include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you want a copy of your receipt. Your receipt can also be printed off from the Oneida County website: <https://oneidacountywi.gov>

The Oneida County Board of Supervisors adopted placing a special charge of \$5.00 per (POWTS) Private On-Site Wastewater Treatment System (septic). This charge will be titled 'POWTS Maintenance Program Fee' on your tax bill. Contact 715-369-6176 or <https://oneidacountywi.gov> if you have any questions regarding this.

The Town of Woodboro will be revalued for real estate assessment purposes in 2026. The revaluation process is required when assessments begin to reflect only a percentage of current market values. That value is shown on your tax bill as the average assessment ratio. The revaluation will bring the assessments into compliance with State Statutes. This process does not generate additional taxes. The general increase in assessment values typically decreases the tax rate.

Revaluation notices are expected to be sent to property owners in September 2026.

The Oneida County Board passed a Resolution #32-2023 which has increased the dog license fees to help offset the contract costs with the Oneida County Humane Society. **The fee is \$10.00 for spayed/neutered dogs: \$20.00 for unspayed/unneutered dogs.** Please be sure to have the correct rabies vaccination information.
