

**Resolution 5-2021**

**RESOLUTION OF A TOWN TO ALLOW A HUMANE SOCIETY  
TO VOLUNTARILY BECOME A DOG LICENSE COLLECTING OFFICIAL  
FOR THE TOWN**

**Town of Woodboro, Oneida County**

Whereas, the Wisconsin State Statutes Chapter 174.065 allows a town by resolution to allow a humane society to voluntarily become a dog licensing collecting official for the town;

Whereas, the Town of Woodboro is under a county agreement with a humane society to act as a pound or stray hold facility, for all areas outside the city of Rhinelander limits;


Whereas, under the contract between the county and humane society the Oneida County Humane Society (OCHS) shall have the duty to pick up and detain stray animals on a 24-hour, 365 days-a-year basis;

THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Woodboro, Oneida County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

1. The Town Board approves to appoint the Oneida County Humane Society to become a voluntary dog license collecting official for the town.
2. OCHS will provide licenses for all adoptions and return of unlicensed stray dogs owned or harbored by residents of the Town of Woodboro.
3. OCHS shall collect the fee and issue the dog license on behalf of the Town of Woodboro and forward that fee onto the Oneida County Treasurer.
4. OCHS shall keep full and accurate records of all persons for whom a dog license has been issued on behalf of the Town of Woodboro.
