

# Town of Woodboro Board of Supervisors

## Monthly meeting minutes

Monday, June 8, 2026

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The regular monthly board meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by Chairperson Phil Kriesel. Clerk May confirmed the agenda was posted in appropriate places.

Members present were Chairperson Phil Kriesel, Supervisors Bill Rudis and Amanda Pontell, Treasurer Joann Beltz, and Clerk Judy May. There were 3 audience members present.

Supervisor Rudis made a motion and seconded by Supervisor Pontell to approve the Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes and Board of Review Minutes from May 19, 2026. Motion carried by voice vote.

Supervisor Rudis made a motion to accept the June 2026 Expenditures as presented. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Pontell. Motion carried by voice vote.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Beltz reported an adjusted balance of \$809,540.53.

### **New Business:**

1. Kyle Kilbourn-Oneida County Supervisor report. Kyle was present to report on the following topics being discussed at the Oneida County Board:
  - a. Officers re-elected for leadership on the board. Kyle was appointed to several committees.
  - b. Discussed new positions that were hired for O.C.
  - c. Public Works department committee was split into two separate committees.
  - d. DNR updates.
  - e. Announced open positions and the process to apply.
  - f. Plan Committee is meeting on June 11<sup>th</sup> to discuss data center moratorium.The board asked Kyle follow-up questions to find out more about his background, and if there are new grant opportunities available to the town.

### **Old Business:**

1. Town Roads Report. No new report yet from Bowens-will give more at June 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting.
  - a. Tree removed from Hancock-Oneida Rd.
  - b. Update on new material being used on Nose Lake Rd/Trout Creek Rd.
2. Sand/Salt Storage Shed. Tabled from last month. Consider potential land purchase on Birch Bay Rd from Oneida County. No update from Oneida County. Tabled to next meeting.
3. Loan consideration for Old Cty K Rd project. Tabled from last month.
  - a. Review loan paperwork for disbursements. Clerk May shared the most recent paperwork received from BCPL loan which included the repayment schedule, and a letter stating that a \$300,000 deposit was made into the checking account on 6/1/26. Discussion regarding next payment request.
