No Parking on County Park Rd. Ordinance #5-19

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Woodboro Oneida County

SECTION I - TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Woodboro No Parking Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate for public safety reasons parking concerns on County Park Rd.

SECTION II - AUTHORITY

The town board has the specific authority under 66.0103, Wis. stats. to prepare and enact this No Parking on County Park Rd. ordinance.

SECTION III - ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the parking on County Park Rd. in the Town of Woodboro.

SECTION IV - SUBDIVISION AND NUMBERING OF THIS ORDINANCE

This ordinance is divided into sections designated by uppercase Roman numerals. Sections may be divided into subsections designated by uppercase letters. Subsections may be divided into paragraphs designated by numbers. Paragraphs may be divided into subdivisions designated by lowercase letters. Subdivisions may be divided into subdivision paragraphs designated by lowercase Roman numerals. Reference to a "section," "subsection," "paragraph," or "subdivision" includes all divisions of the referenced section, subsection, paragraph, or subdivision.

SECTION V - PUBLIC SAFETY

No person may park any motorized vehicle on either side of County Park Rd. in the Town of Woodboro.

SECTION VI – ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS

SECTION VII - ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS

A. Penalties.

- 1. 1st Offense. Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than \$20.
- B. Separate Violations. Each day of violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense.

Oneida County Sheriff's Department will enforce the no parking rules on County Park Rd. and may issue a parking citation. Violators may also have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense.

SECTION VIII - SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION IX - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
